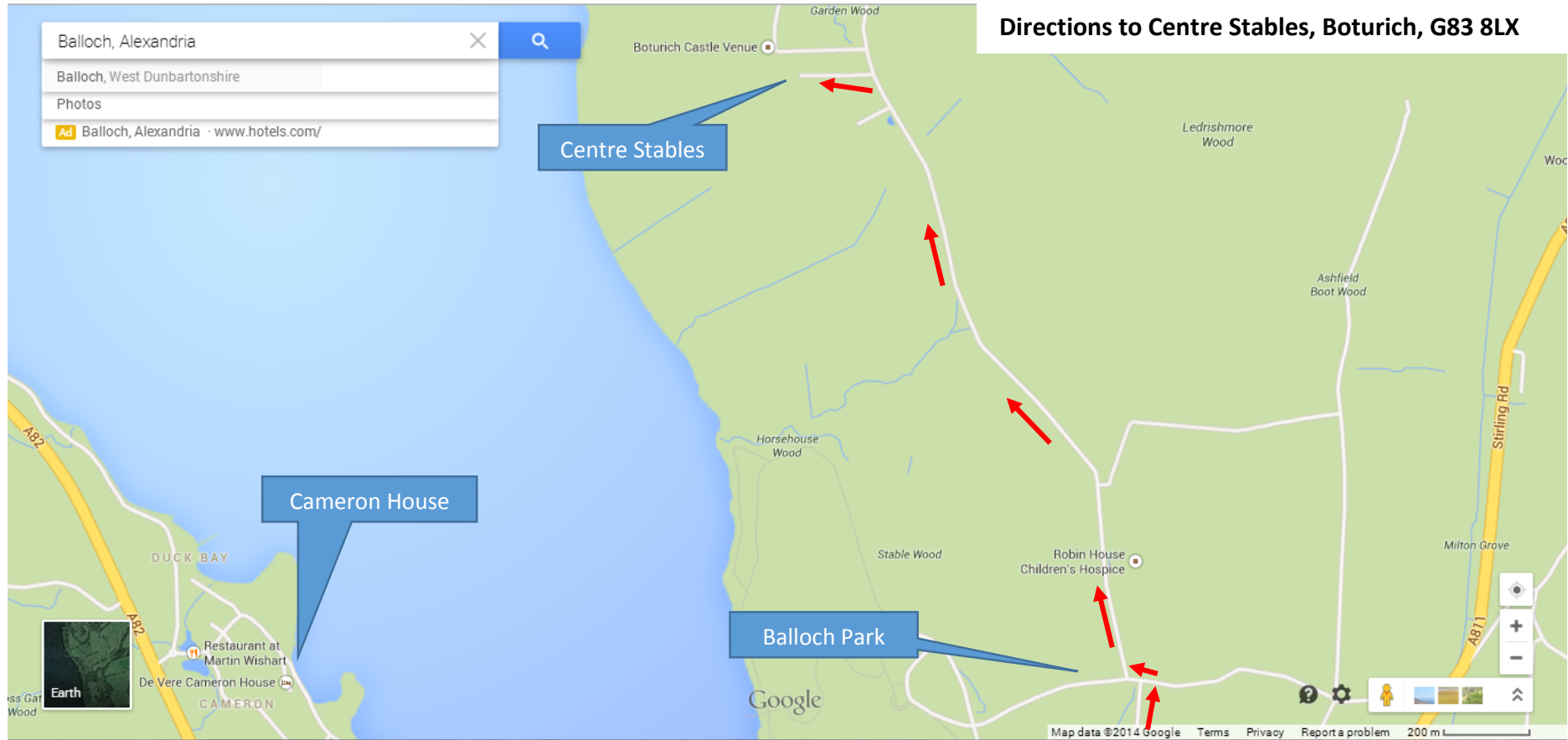


Directions to Centre Stables, Boturich, G83 8LX



1. **Directions:** Postcode as above will take you close if you have Sat Nav. Go through Balloch itself, as this is the easiest route.
 - a. Once on Balloch main street, follow right through the town until the end, turning left at a sign marked Children's Hospice (Mollanbowie Road)
 - b. Follow this road all the way up hill and round bends, turning right at the entrance to Balloch Castle Country Park (see map)
 - c. Continue up hill, past Children's Hospice and carry on for about one mile, through gates saying Private Road.
 - d. Turn left when you see a sign with a number of house names on it (the next left is the Castle – if you see this, you have gone too far)
 - e. Follow the lane downhill for 200 yards – our building is now in front of you
 - f. Before you reach the building, look for a narrow grey track on your **left**
 - g. Take this track and swing round behind the building
 - h. Turn through the cream stone pillars into the cobbled courtyard
 - i. You have arrived!
 - j. The house entry door is to the left of the canopy

2. **Keys:** These are in a key safe on the wall, two feet off the ground, to the **right** of the house door
 - a. Slide down the black cover of the key safe
 - b. Turn combination to code as supplied by caretaker
 - c. Press down black "switch" to open and retrieve keys. Whilst there is a security light that comes on when you approach the door, you may find it useful to have a small torch handy to see the combination clearly at night.

3. **Outside:**
 - a. Centre Stables owns the whole courtyard, so safe area to play and relax, but please watch out for uneven cobbles!
 - b. Also small grass area with sheds (and swing!) is ours.
 - c. You can park your car anywhere in the courtyard, as you wish, but please note that neighbours' windows overlook the courtyard, so please park considerately
 - d. There is no loch access from our property – please do not trespass on other people's land
 - e. The approach road is private, but visitors are welcome to walk or cycle on it and there are rewarding views of the loch further up this road.

4. **WARNING:** whilst we take every reasonable precaution to ensure your safety, please note that this is an old house in a beautiful rural location. Local hazards include: uneven and boggy ground; uneven slippery cobbles, liable to icing; very dark conditions outside at night; permanently hot Aga cooker, etc. We do not accept any liability for any damage to your property or any injury you might sustain whilst you are renting here.
